**COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROVIDE CITIZENS WITH UPDATED STATE OF THE COUNTY
REPORT**

BUCYRUS – Crawford County Commissioners, Gary Miller, Mo Ressallat and Doug Weisenauer announced today that an update to the County’s February “State of the County Report” is now available.

The condition of the national, state and local economy prompted the Board of County Commissioners, with the support of elected officials and department heads, to prepare this report for the purpose of communicating with citizens about current financial and public policy issues facing the County.

County Commissioner Gary Miller said, “This update to the State of the County Report is being provided to the public in our on-going attempt to communicate with citizens about the financial condition of the County’s General Operating Fund, including public safety.” Efforts by County officials to maintain services, reduce spending, and enhance revenues are outlined in this supplemental report and will provide the community with updated financial information and data.

Also included in this report is a detailed explanation of the financial changes that have been made by all County officials to permanently reduce spending. “Crawford County is very fortunate to have so many dedicated officials who are willing to work together and who are responsible stewards of your tax dollars,” says County Commissioner Doug Weisenauer.

County Commissioner Mo Ressallat would like to thank the community for supporting the criminal justice services levy and encourages taxpayers to review “The Updated State of the County Report”.
